Townhome Association Annual Membership Meeting

Dear Townhome Owners,

We are pleased to announce that the Residences at Tohoqua Community Association Annual Membership Meeting is almost here. During this years annual membership meeting, the residents will be electing and voting for a new board member. Each year, one seat of the Board of Directors is up for reelection. This means that residents have an opportunity to elect themselves or another townhome owner as a candidate to run for a board seat.

The board members may be as involved as their time allows. They will be making decisions regarding all association business. This includes contracts, bids, enforcement and adopting the yearly budget.

The townhome association will hold as many or little meetings as the board chooses. The requirement is that a yearly Membership meeting is held and a yearly Board of Directors meeting is held to adopt the next year's budget.

Whats next:

A mailed notice will be provided to each member (unit owners only). It will state the time, date and agenda for the meeting. Please note that the Annual Membership Meeting is for choosing your board members and to discuss additional townhome business. The mailed notice will also include an Intent to Run Form and a Candidate Information Sheet. If you would like to run for the board seat, please fill out the two forms and return them to the management company.

Then a Second Notice of the Meeting will be mailed to each member. The second notice will include the candidates information. Each member will have the opportunity to review the items in order to make an informed decision. This second notice will also include a voting proxy. It is imperative that you provide your voting proxy. This form will serve two purposes. 1. It will determine a quorum for the meeting and 2. It will provide your vote.

Each household may submit one vote per household only. Be sure to pay attention to deadlines. Any documents that need to be returned can be mailed to our mailing address, dropped off at the onsite office or be placed in the lock box located in the fitness center. The fitness center is opened daily from 4:30am - 11:00pm.

We are extremely excited to bring our townhome community together and bring on a new board member. STAY TUNED for further information as our meeting approaches.

Political Yard Signs

- * Must be a standard yard sign size.
- * Must be installed no earlier than Sunday, October 9th, thirty (30) days before the election day.
- * Must be removed no later than Thursday, November 10th, forty-eight (48) hours after the elections.
- * One (1) candidate sign per lot.

Holiday Decorations

Owners may display a reasonable number of holiday decorations, beginning no more than 30 days prior to a publicly observed holiday or religious observance and remaining up for no more than 20 days thereafter. Holiday decoration schedule for Tohoqua as follows:

- * Halloween: no earlier than Saturday, October 1, 2022.
- * Thanksgiving: no earlier than Tuesday, October 25, 2022.
- * Christmas, New Year's and/or Religious Observance: no earlier than Thursday, November 24th and removed no later than Saturday, January 21, 2023.

Plants and Plant Pots

As stated in the community's Design Review Manual, not more than five (5) landscape pots equal to or less than twenty-four inches (24") that are visible from the street are permitted within any Lot. All landscape pots which are visible from the street must be earth tone in color.

In preparation of the holiday season, the association encourages residents to pressure wash their driveways and sidewalks.

Community Friendly Reminders

- Community Ponds The ponds in the community are retention ponds. No swimming, fishing or boating is allowed.
- Street Parking The Tohoqua Master Association kindly asks you to be courteous of your neighbors and park your cars in your garage or on your driveway. This applies for the residents and visitors.
- Trash Cans As stated in the Design Review Manual, "all trash containers must be stored in the rear yard or garage and out of view of the street on non-collection days. Garbage cans and trash containers shall not be placed outside the home for pick-up earlier than 7:00pm on the day preceding the pick-up and shall be removed the day of pick-up". Please discontinue leaving the trash receptacles in public view on noncollection days and follow the schedule as stated in the community declaration. Also, trash cans cannot be placed directly in the crosswalks, in the pedestrian path ways. As a friendly reminder, trash pickup days are:

Tuesdays: Trash (Brown)
Wednesdays: Yard (Green)
Fridays: Recycling (Blue)

Lock Box - In need to make an assessment or event payment or submit a DRB Application and can't make it to the onsite management office? For your convenience, a lock box was installed in the fitness center which opens daily from 4:30 am until 11:00 pm.



Community/Builder Dumpsters -

Residents may NOT use the community/builder dumpsters for their bulk trash. This includes any building materials from resident contractors.

Please be advised that this is considered illegal dumping and is punishable by law. Under Florida State Statute 403.413, it is illegal to dump, discard, place, throw, dispose, or deposit any rubbish, waste, or trash onto any property (private or public) without consent. Fines associated with Felony Littering can cost an offender anywhere between \$100 - \$500.

DRB LANDSCAPE APPLICATION

As a friendly reminder, all modifications/additions to the exterior (front, side and rear) of the home requires a DRB application approval from the Board *prior* to the job being scheduled and completed.
